**(Hebrews 1:8-12)**

**I. BY THE EARLY CHURCH**

- 1. Ignatius of Antioch – “Jesus Christ our God” – A.D. 110.**
  
- 2. Aristides – “Christians acknowledge God . . . in the only-begotten Son” – A.D. 140.**
  
- 3. Tatian the Syrian – “We report that God was born in the form of a man” – A.D. 170.**
  
- 4. Melito of Sardis – “Being God and likewise perfect man” – A.D. 177.**
  
- 5. Irenaeus – “Jesus Christ, our Lord and God and Savior and King” – A.D. 189.**

**II. BY THE BIBLE**

**1. Jesus is the creator of everything.**

*He also says, “In the beginning, O Lord, you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. (Hebrews 1:10) NIV*

**2. Jesus is eternal and unchanging.**

*They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed. But you remain the same, and your years will never end. (Hebrews 1:11-12) NIV*

**3. Jesus is God!**

*“I and the Father are one.” Again the Jews picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus said to them, “I have shown you many great miracles from the Father. For which of these do you stone me?” “We are not stoning you for any of these,” replied the Jews, “but for blasphemy, because you, a mere man, claim to be God.” (John 10:30-33) NIV*

*Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob are their ancestors, and Christ himself was an Israelite as far as his human nature is concerned. And he is God, the one who rules over everything and is worthy of eternal praise! Amen. (Romans 9:5) NLT*

*We are filled with hope, as we wait for the glorious return of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ. (Titus 2:13) CEV*

### **III. BY YOUR LIFE!**

#### **1. Jesus holds the key to your eternal future!**

*When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: “Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades. (Revelation 1:17-18) NIV*

#### **2. Therefore, Jesus demands your best and your all.**

*If you want to be my disciple, you must hate everyone else by comparison—your father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even your own life. Otherwise, you cannot be my disciple. And if you do not carry your own cross and follow me, you cannot be my disciple. (Luke 14:26-27) NLT*

*In the same way, any of you who does not give up everything he has cannot be my disciple. (Luke 14:33) NIV*
