WHO I AM (1 Peter 1:1-5)

I. I AM CHOSEN BY GOD

- God has chosen me, not to be overcome by temptation, but to overcome temptation.

For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. (Romans 8:29) NIV

II. I AM HOLY

- When I set my mind on the word, not the world, I allow God to set me apart and make me holy.

For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love (Ephesians 1:4) NIV

III. I AM OBEDIENT

The sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God. (Romans 8:7-8) NIV

- My obedience is not the cause of salvation, but the proof and the result of salvation.

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (Ephesians 2:10) NIV

IV. I AM BORN AGAIN

- My new life is "God-caused,"
- My new life is "God-caused," "God-powered"
- My new life is "God-caused," "God-powered" and "God-sustained."

You have been born again, and this new life did not come from something that dies, but from something that cannot die. You were born again through God's living message that continues forever. (1 Peter 1:23) NCV

IV. I AM THE RECEIVER OF GREAT GIFTS!

Jesus then said, "I am the one who raises the dead to life! Everyone who has faith in me will live, even if they die. And everyone who lives because of faith in me will never really die. Do you believe this?" (John 11:25-26) CEV

1. My "living hope" produces joy in my daily life.

Why am I discouraged? Why is my heart so sad? I will put my hope in God! I will praise him again— my Savior and my God! (Psalm 43:5) NLT

2. My inheritance produces peace in my daily life.

How great is the goodness you have stored up for those who fear you. You lavish it on those who come to you for protection, blessing them before the watching world. (Psalm 31:19) NLT
