WHAT I WILL DO (1 Peter 1:13-19)

I. I WILL WORK ACTIVELY FOR GOD (vs.13)

1. I will ruthlessly remove everything that might trip me up!

Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist. (Ephesians 6:14a) NIV

2. I will let nothing – except Jesus Christ – dominate my life.

- Outlook determines outcome.

Be on your guard! Don't let yourselves become occupied with too much feasting and drinking and with the worries of this life, or that Day may suddenly catch you. (Luke 21:34) GNT

- Attitude determines action.

Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. (1 Peter 5:8) NIV

3. I will focus daily on Christ's grace.

Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. (Colossians 3:2) NIV

II. I WILL BE HOLY – IN EVERYTHING (vss.14-16)

1. My mold will be Christ's character.

You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness. (Ephesians 4:22-24) NIV

2. My goal will be God's holiness.

Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires. (2 Peter 1:4) NIV

III. I WILL ALWAYS REMEMBER HOW – AND BY WHOM – I WAS PURCHASED (vss.17-19)

At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another. (Titus 3:3) NIV

- **From this moment on, I reject emptiness and embrace Christ's forgiveness and His call to service.**

How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! (Hebrews 9:14) NIV
