MY PRIVATE LIFE
(Romans 8:38-39)

I. WHEN I REFUSE TO DEAL WITH THE “GARBAGE” . . .

1. My garbage stops progress in my life.

Because of your wrath there is no health in my body; my bones have no soundness because of my sin. (Psalm 38:3) NIV

2. My garbage starts to smell good to me.

There are people who think they are pure when they are as filthy as they can be. (Proverbs 30:12) GNT

3. My garbage hurts everyone around me.

Although you wash yourself with soda and use an abundance of soap, the stain of your guilt is still before me,” declares the Sovereign LORD. (Jeremiah 2:22) NIV

II. WHEN I GIVE GOD MY GARBAGE, HE . . .

1. Gets rid of my garbage . . . and He cleanses the container.

2. Keeps my container clean every day.
