LUKEWARM
(Revelation 3:14-22)

MY DILEMMA

1. I've become satisfied with a mediocre life – which **God detests**. (vss.15-16)
2. My focus is on the wrong things – which can **lead me far from God**. (vss.17-18a)

THE BIBLE'S SOLUTION

1. Ask God to **reignite a passion** to live for Him – whatever the cost. (vs.18a)

These have come so that your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may be proved genuine and may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. (1 Peter 1:7) NIV

2. Ask God – daily – to **purify you completely**. (vs.18b)

I delight greatly in the Lord; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. (Isaiah 61:10) NIV

3. Ask God to give you **His vision for the world** – and be satisfied with **nothing less!** (vs.18c)

For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But if anyone does not have them, he is nearsighted and blind, and has forgotten that he has been cleansed from his past sins. (2 Peter 1:5-9) NIV

GOD'S PROMISES

1. Jesus offers you a **dynamic relationship with Him** – right now!

This day I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live (Deuteronomy 30:19) NIV

2. You will reign with Him in power – true value and wealth! (vs.21)

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. And so through him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God. (2 Corinthians 1:20) NIV
