THE CRASH (2 Corinthians 1:3-4)

I. WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I CRASH?

1. God “black flags” me to protect me from further damage.

Cling to your faith in Christ, and keep your conscience clear. For some people have deliberately violated their consciences; as a result, their faith has been shipwrecked. Hymenaeus and Alexander are two examples. I threw them out and handed them over to Satan so they might learn not to blaspheme God. (1 Timothy 1:19-20) NLT

2. God “black flags” me to protect others from damage.

As I urged you when I went into Macedonia, stay there in Ephesus so that you may command certain men not to teach false doctrines any longer (1 Timothy 1:3) NIV

II. AFTER I CRASH, IS THERE HOPE?

1. God’s reason for punishing me is to get me ready for the race once more.

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. See what this godly sorrow has produced in you: what earnestness, what eagerness to clear yourselves, what indignation, what alarm, what longing, what concern, what readiness to see justice done. At every point you have proved yourselves to be innocent in this matter. (2 Corinthians 7:10-11) NIV.

2. God can use my crash to keep others from crashing.

And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. (Romans 8:28) NLT
